






#### **Typical Section Locations** Post Transition, Urban, City Transition, and Greenway Zones










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
#### **Proposed Post Transition Zone:** East of Fort Hood St. to West of Root Ave.





#### Proposed Urban Zone: East of Root Avenue to West of 14<sup>th</sup> Street






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
#### Proposed City Transition Zone: East of 14<sup>th</sup> Street to West of W.S. Young Drive






#### Proposed Greenway Zone: East of W.S. Young Drive to West of 38<sup>th</sup> Street

#### **Right-of-Way and Potential Displacements**



- The proposed project would require approximately 2.7 acres of additional ROW
- No displacements are anticipated
- The project would require some construction and utility easements




#### **Environmental Constraints Map**


